\*The decline of 6.6% in overall enrollment when comparing Summer 2004 with Summer 2003 is deceptive and caused by unusual circumstances wherein a class in Nursing was required to attend in the summer to aid in effecting a curriculum change for the Fall term. This inflated the Summer 2003 enrollment and these data also make some academic and demographic comparisons between terms unreliable. The Summer 2002 enrollment was 702. Summer 2003 had a projected enrollment of 825. Therefore the enrollment of 929 for Summer 2004 represents an approximate 13% increase.
