Students who are admitted to OLOL College and meet the following minimum criteria may apply for consideration.

- High School GPA of 3.0 or better
- ACT Composite score of 21 or SAT Composite score of 990

Candidates will be evaluated based on their academic credentials, leadership and activity record, and essay.

Recipients are offered a scholarship package valued at \$2500 per semester for up to eight semesters. Continued scholarship eligibility is contingent upon a 3.0 GPA and service to the College through various activities.
