Prerequisites for Provider & Renewal Course

- ❶ Obtain ACLS course text & student CD (*given with required course registration*)
- ❷ Completion of the 3 pre-course assessments (*ECG Recognition, ACLS Drugs, ACLS Algorithms*) with a score of **80%** on each Completion Certificates with scores are printed from the student CD and are required for admission
- ❸ Ability to demonstrate CPR/AED use according to the 2005 AHA Guidelines

COURSE OBJECTIVES *At the conclusion of this course, participants will be able to:*

- Recognize and initiate early management of peri-arrest conditions that may result in cardiac arrest or complicate resuscitation outcome
- Demonstrate proficiency in providing BLS care, including prioritizing chest compressions and integrating AED use
- Manage cardiac arrest until the return of spontaneous circulation, transfer of care, or termination of resuscitation efforts.
- Identify and treat ischemic chest pain and expedite the care of patients with acute coronary syndromes
- Recognize other life-threatening clinical situations, such as stroke, and provide effective initial care and transfer to reduce disability and death
- Demonstrate effective communication as a member or leader of a resuscitation team and recognize the impact of team dynamics on overall team performance

CONTINUING EDUCATION

Provider Course: 11.0 contact hours will be awarded for successful completion of this activity. Our Lady of the Lake College is an approved provider of continuing nursing education by the Louisiana State Nurses Association, an accredited approver by the American Nurses Credentialing Center's Commission on Accreditation.
