Upon successful completion of this course, Instructors will be able to instruct all AHA BLS courses: Healthcare Provider CPR, Heartsaver CPR/AED, Family & Friends CPR, CPR in Schools, First Aid, & Pediatric First Aid.

**Prerequisites for BLS-I course**

- 1 Course registration and completion of Core Instructor CD (*supplied with registration*)  
\*Completion Certificate printed from the CD is required for admission to the course\*
- 2 Proof of acceptance for Instructor status affiliation by an AHA Training Center
- 3 Current valid AHA Healthcare Provider CPR card
- 4 Willingness to be monitored while successfully teaching initial BLS course

**Course Objectives**

*At the conclusion of the course, the Participant will be able to*

- Organize physical facilities for an effective CPR classroom, including all course materials
- Identify the BLS course and AHA course video appropriate for the needs of the participant group
- Describe scientific background when answering questions concerning aspects of the 2005 Guidelines
- Instruct a group using AHA practice-while-watching video while following course lesson maps
- Evaluate BLS skills using the AHA Skills Testing Checklist
- Organize the process of written examination and describe options for successful remediation
- Follow procedures for effectively cleaning and decontaminating CPR manikins
