: Prerequisites for PALS-I course

- ❶ Course registration and completion of Core Instructor CD (*supplied with registration*)
Completion Certificate printed from the CD is required for admission to the course
- ❷ Proof of acceptance for Instructor status affiliation by an AHA Training Center
- ❸ Current valid AHA PALS Provider card and Healthcare Provider CPR card
- ❹ Willingness to be monitored while successfully teaching initial PALS course

Course Objectives

At the conclusion of this course, participants will be able to:

- Organize and conduct a PALS course using the video and lesson maps in the PALS course instructor materials
- Instruct on the team concept of PALS management
- Guide and evaluate students during practice stations and Megacode while correctly using the PALS skills testing checklist
- Understand the concept of student remediation and demonstrate effective remediation techniques
- Explain AHA and Training Center policies concerning PALS courses, completion of course forms, and the process for instructor renewal
