

Associate of Science in Arts and Sciences

History and Purpose

In the summer of 1997, the Associate of Science Degree in Arts and Sciences was established. The Associate of Science Degree provides foundational courses in arts and sciences, demonstrating the College's commitment to life-long learning through programs designed to further enhance academic, personal and professional growth, and the continuation of higher education and scholarly pursuits.

Enrollment

Students may enroll in arts and sciences courses for the spring, summer, and/or fall semesters. Course offerings may vary each semester. A current course listing will be published prior to pre-registration in the fall and spring. Students may take courses on a full-time or part-time basis.

Application Procedures

Interested persons may submit applications at anytime during the year. However, in order to ensure timely processing, applications should be submitted by the priority deadline date in the spring for summer and fall, and fall for spring semester. It is the applicant's responsibility to verify the status of their application and provide all required documentation.

Financial Assistance

Our Lady of the Lake College has financial aid counselors available to assist students with the financial aid process. All students are encouraged to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form preferably by all applicable priority deadline dates.

Transferability

Credit earned at a regionally accredited college or university is transferable provided the course is equivalent in content to the course offered at Our Lady of the College. A final grade of C or better must be earned in courses to be transferred. Credit for college level achievement may be awarded through the CLEP and/or ACT/PEP examination. Academic Advising, New Student Packet

After admission to the college, all students will be assigned an academic advisor. The academic advisor will be a member of the Arts and Sciences faculty. A meeting with the advisor is required before new and re-entry students may proceed with pre-registration/registration activities.

Enrollment is based on availability of courses. Once the admission status has been determined, the applicant will be notified by mail as time permits.
