

**SCHOOL OF ARTS, SCIENCES AND HEALTH PROFESSIONS
POST-BACCALAUREATE PRE-MEDICAL PROGRAM
(Non-degree)**

This program is designed for those students who already possess a B.A. or B.S. degree, but lack specific course work required for admission into medical (and dental schools.)

Typical courses include science courses in the areas of Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Mathematics. Our Lady of the Lake College offers pre-med level courses required for matriculation into medical/dental school as part of its Human Medicine B.S. degree program. Students holding B.A. or B.S. degrees in non-life science fields are encouraged to apply.

Application Procedures

Interested persons may submit applications at anytime during the year. However, in order to ensure timely processing, applications should be submitted by the priority deadline date in the spring for summer and fall, and fall for spring semester. It is the applicant's responsibility to verify the status of their application and provide all required documentation.

Transferability

Credit earned at a regionally accredited college or university is transferable provided the course is equivalent in content to the course offered at Our Lady of the Lake College. A final grade of C or better must be earned in courses to be transferred. Credit for college level achievement may be awarded through the CLEP and/or ACT/PEP examination.
